Her stories lean into emotional truth, ensemble dynamics, and speculative elements that challenge conventional arcs, offering not just escape, but resonance. It's storytelling with a pulse, a purpose, and a dash of stardust.

She writes monthly on Substack exploring agency, quiet faith, and ensemble dynamics within immersive YA science fiction and fantasy settings. Whether reflecting on the shadow side of agency, the unconventional possibilities in character-driven narratives, or the fast-and-feels dynamic of YA sci-fi, Annie brings a voice that's heartfelt, reader-focused, and intellectually grounded.
